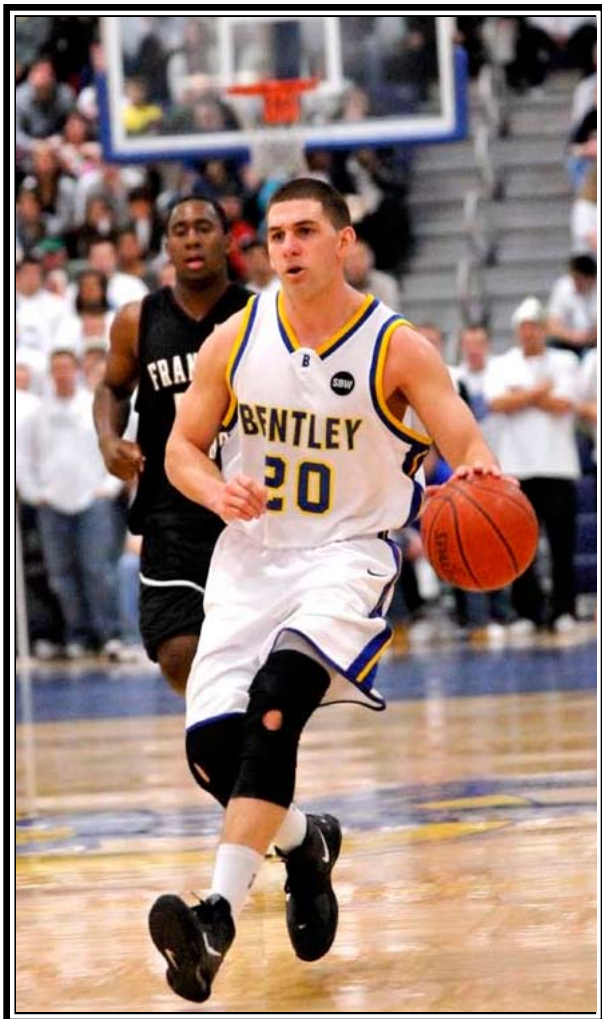

# Bentley's Westrol Named 2010 DIIB Player of the Year

Bentley College senior Jason Westrol been named the 2010 *Division II Bulletin* Player of the Year.

Westrol averaged 21.2 points, 5.4 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 2.3 steals this season and had the highest Falcon scoring average in the past 20 years. He was the Northeast-10 Player of the Year, the second player in school history to reach the 2,000-point milestone, and is the school's all-time leader in games started, consecutive starts, minutes played, field goals made and field goals attempted.

He's taken to the court 132 times in his career and has left with a victory 117 times, a remarkable winning percentage of .886.

"Jason had an unbelievable year and carried his team to the highest stage in Division II basketball," said *DIIB* editor Gary Rubin. "He was the engine that made his team go and he is most deserving of this award."

Westrol headlines the *DIIB* All-American team, where he was joined on the first team by Kutztown's Stephen Dennis, St. Cloud St.'s Matt Schneck, Southern Indiana's Jamar Smith, and Central Missouri's Sanijay Watts.

Division II Bulletin has named a Player of the Year every season since the 1991-92 season.
