Cabrini College senior guard Aaron Walton-Moss has been named the 2015 *DIII News* Player of the Year.

The *DIIIN* Preseason Player of the Year, Walton-Moss was statistically dominant this season and was the only player to rank in the top 25 in points, rebounds and assists. He averaged 20.6 points, 11.7 rebounds and led Division III with 8.8 assists per game. He was named the Player of the Year in the Colonial State Athletics Conference for the third straight season and closed his career as Cabrini's all-time leader with 1,641 points and 906 rebounds, while his 495 career assists rank third.

"Heading into this season Aaron was the player to beat for this award and he went out and had a tremendous season individually while leading his team to the NCAA tournament," said DIII News editor Gary Rubin. "He is most deserving."

Walton-Moss is joined on the 2015 DIIIN All-American team by Gordon Lyons of Geneseo, Bethel's Kyle Zimmerman, Dickinson senior Gerry Wixted, and Wisconsin Whitewater guard Quardell Young.

DIIIN has selected a Player of the Year every season since 1993-94.
