FPU's Leedham Named 2010 WDIIB Player of the Year

Franklin Pierce University senior Johannah Leedham has been named the 2010 *Women's Division II Bulletin* Player of the Year.

Leedham, the publication's Preseason Player of the Year, led the country in scoring at 27.1 points per game also grabbed 8 rebounds per contest. She guided the Ravens to their third straight regional title while collecting her third consecutive Northeast-10 Player of the Year honor. She broke the all-time Division II scoring record this season and ranks in the top 25 in scoring across all divisions.

To top off her season, she was named British Basketball's 2009 Athlete of the Year.

"Johannah had one of the all-time great seasons for a Division II player," said *WDIIB* editor Gary Rubin. "She dominated in every facet of the game. She'll rank as one of the best to play at this level. She is most deserving."

Leedham headlines the 2010 *WDIIB* All-American team, where she was joined on the first team by Shippensburg's Lauren Beckley, Emporia State's Cassandra Boston, Tusculum's Jasmine Gunn, and Michigan Tech's Katie Wysocky.
