He was a first-team College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin selection and the league's Most Valuable Player.

"Kent came back for another year of basketball and proved that he is a top player at this level," said *DIII News* Editor Gary Rubin, "There were many candidates for this award, but at the end of the day we felt Kent was the most deserving."

Raymond was joined on the *DIIIN* All-American first team by Capital senior Nate Stahl, Randolph-Macon senior Justin Short and a pair of juniors, Washington University's Aaron Thompson and Wisconsin Oshkosh's D.J. Marsh.
